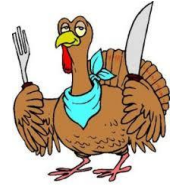
BAKE SALE each third Saturday of the month – October 20th - Ladies bring your items for sale everyone looks forward to those tasty desserts, breads, etc. for sale.
